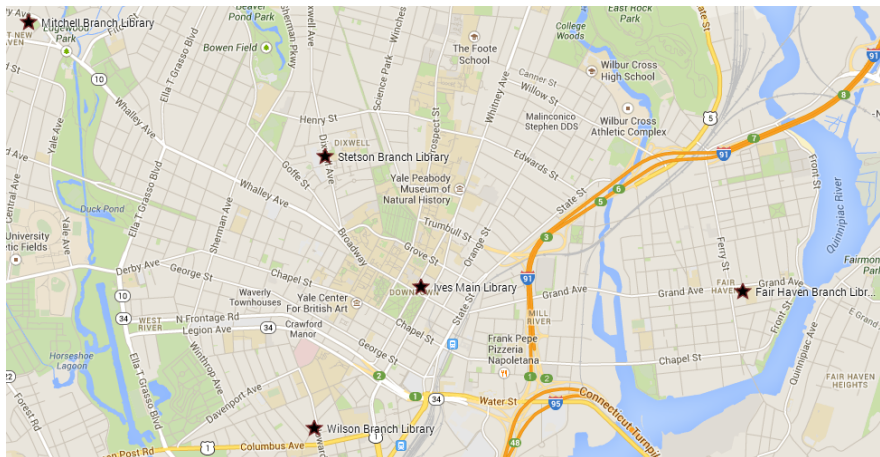

Read

Play

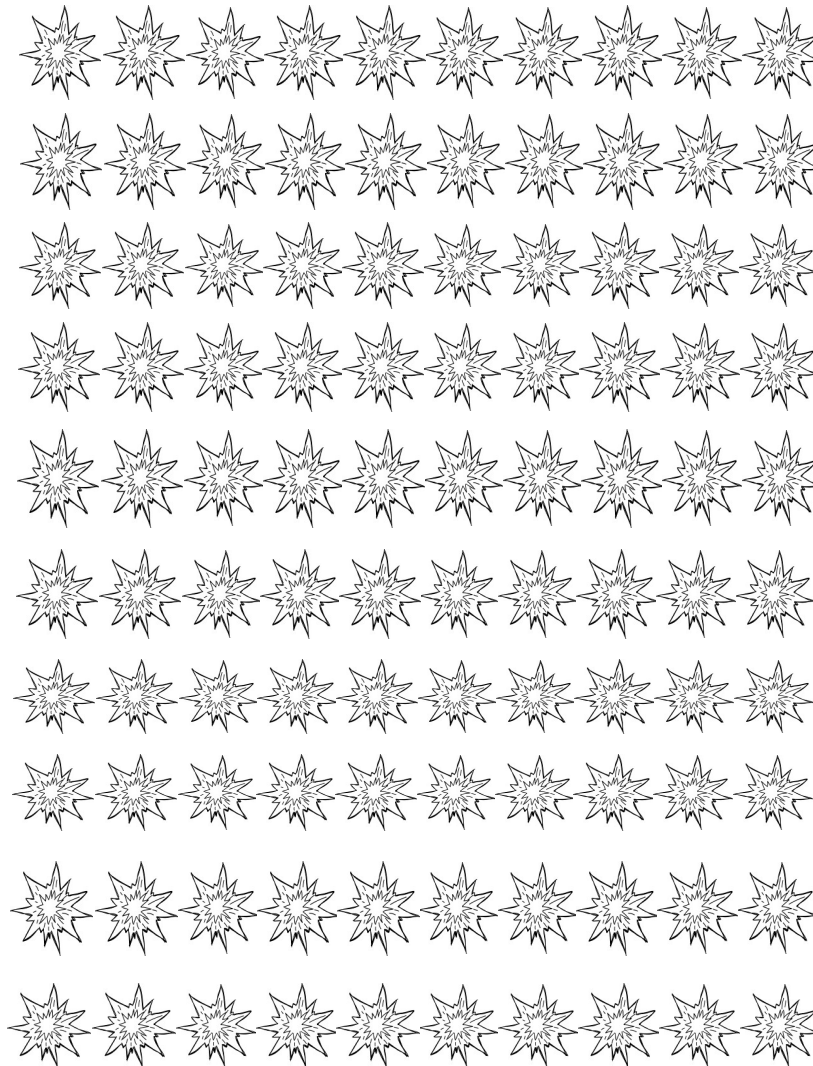
